Sex: Male or Female

Age Group: 18 years and over

Inclusion Criteria:

1. people who have Schizophrenia, Schizoaffective disorder, Psychosis, Major depressive disorder with psychotic features, or Bipolar disorder with psychotic features 2. between ages 18 and 30 except: Alabama & Nebraska 19 to 30 and Mississippi 21 to 30 3. able to read and speak English, 4. no hospitalizations for mental health issues in the past month 5. have access to a computer with internet connection 6. permanent resident of the United States

Exclusion Criteria:

1. history of substance abuse in the past month 2. diagnosed with a neurological disorder 3. cognitive training in the past 6 months
