Sex: Male or Female

Inclusion Criteria:

- 4 to 65 years of age - diagnosis of Muscular Dystrophy with weakness in either a limb-girdle pattern, or in a arm or leg - confirmed mutation in ANO5, CAPN3, DYSF, DNAJB6 or SGCA-G.

Exclusion Criteria:

- bleeding disorder, platelet count less than 50,000, or currently taking an anticoagulant. - women who are pregnant - other illness that would interfere clinical trial (study staff will review)

Description: The purpose of this study to learn more about Limb Girdle Muscular Dystrophy by measuring how muscles change over a twelve-month period. Our clinical evaluator will test muscle strength and participants will be asked to complete a series of questionnaires to find out how Limb Girdle impacts daily activities. This information will help plan future studies and drug development for people with LGMD.

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
