**Sex:** Male or Female

**Inclusion Criteria:**

- ages 1 to 17 who have an adult (parent or caregiver) who is also willing to participate - able to read and communicate in English - Autism group: children with a previous diagnosis or concern about autism - Non-autism group: children with or without a previous diagnosis or concern about another developmental or psychiatric condition

**Exclusion Criteria:**

- significant visual or auditory impairments that would make it difficult to complete standard testing - severe mental illness or medical condition that is not currently managed and would interfere with the completion of the testing

**Description:** The purpose of this research is to find out whether the Autism Diagnostic Interview, 3rd edition (ADI-3) is useful for gathering information to help with the diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder (autism). Parents/caregivers will be asked to complete questionnaires and participate in two separate interviews about your child (the focus participant). We estimate that one interview will take 2-3 hours and the other will take 3-4 hours. Children will be asked to complete questionnaires (if they are able) and an in-person assessment that will take approximately 3-4 hours.
