Eligibility Criteria

Sex: Male or Female Age Group: 18 years and over This study is also accepting healthy volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- healthy volunteers without systemic or respiratory disease - non-smokers or former smokers who quit more than 6 months ago (including marijuana) - ages 18-50 - preferred but not required: have lived in countries in Africa, Latino America or South East Asia - preferred but not required: history of positive tuberculosis (TB) skin or blood test

Exclusion Criteria:

- recent illness, bleeding disorders, or a history of heart, lung, or systemic disease - weakened immune system or use of immunosuppressant medication - use of inhaled substances in the past six months or history of heavy smoking - allergy or prior adverse reaction to lidocaine, midazolam, or fentanyl - pregnancy
