Sex: Male or Female

Age Group: 18 years and over

This study is NOT accepting healthy volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- age 18 to 65 - diagnosis of Rapid Eye Movement (RBD) sleep disorder - have repeated episodes of sleep related vocalizations and/or complex motor behaviors - documented by sleep study to occur during REM sleep

Exclusion Criteria:

- diagnosis of Parkinson's disease, dementia, multiple system atrophy or any other cause - unable to have a skin biopsy because of poor wound healing, use of anticoagulants other than aspirin or Plavix, or severe vascular disease
