Eligibility Criteria

Sex: Male or Female

Age Group: 18 years and over This study is NOT accepting healthy

volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- 21+ years of age, with a valid ID - Fluent in English - Report drinking ≥ 2 days/week - Women must report ≥1 drink/day on average over the last 6 months. - Men must report ≥2 drink/day on average over the last 6 months - Diagnosis of TMD, myalgia, TMJ, or a combination - Have a smartphone with Internet

Exclusion Criteria:

- History of any psychotic disorder, current major depression, substance use disorder or current alcohol use disorder - Serious medical illness - Under-controlled hypertension or diabetes or neurological disease - Impaired cognitive function - Women who are pregnant breastfeeding, or intending to become pregnant - Loss of sensation in lower legs or physical inability to complete study tasks - Positive drug screening - Medications that contraindicate alcohol use - Comparison group: Chronic pain & TMD
