- between the ages of 15-39 at the time of their first primary cancer diagnosis of Hodgkin lymphoma or non-Hodgkin lymphoma (NHL) - completed therapy and had with a complete response - last date of prior systemic therapy was no more than one year ago - must be English speaking - have internet access through computer, tablet, or smartphone and an email address - at least able to do limited selfcare, may be confined to bed or chair more than 50% of waking hours - see link to clinicaltrials.gov for complete inclusion criteria
