Sex: Male or Female

Age Group: 18 years and over

This study is NOT accepting healthy volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- currently taking 2 medications for high blood pressure and on a stable treatment plan for at least 30 days - elevated blood pressure despite current treatment - see link to clinicaltrials.gov for complete inclusion criteria

Exclusion Criteria:

- history of certain heart, kidney, or urinary tract conditions - pregnant, breastfeeding, or planning to become pregnant during the study - currently receiving dialysis or prior kidney transplant - currently enrolled in another hypertension study or previously received device-based treatment for high blood pressure - see link to clinicaltrials.gov for complete exclusion criteria
