Eligibility Criteria

Sex: Male or Female

Age Group: 18 years and over

This study is NOT accepting healthy volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- 21 years of age or older - identify as Black or African American - currently smoke cigarettes and meet minimum smoking requirements for the study - willing to make a quit attempt within the next 30 days - see link to ClinicalTrials.gov for complete inclusion criteria

Exclusion Criteria:

- current use of prescription nicotine medications requiring clinical monitoring - medical conditions or medications that may significantly interfere with smoking behavior or study participation - pregnant or breastfeeding - see link to ClinicalTrials.gov for complete exclusion criteria
