Sex: Male or Female

Age Group: Not specified

This study is NOT accepting healthy volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- younger than 39 years old or were first diagnosed with a soft tissue or bone sarcoma before age 39 - have a newly diagnosed, recurrent, or progressive (continued to grow) soft tissue or bone sarcoma - have sarcoma that has spread (metastasized) to another part of the body and can be measured on imaging scans - see link to clinicaltrials.gov for complete inclusion criteria

Exclusion Criteria:

- have cancer that has spread to the brain or spinal fluid - have metastatic disease that cannot be measured on imaging scans - pregnant or breastfeeding - see link to clinicaltrials.gov for complete exclusion criteria
