Eligibility Criteria

Sex: Male or Female

Age Group: 18 years and over

This study is NOT accepting healthy volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- between 18 and 35 years old - diagnosis of a psychosis-related condition, such as schizophrenia, schizoaffective disorder, schizophreniform disorder, psychosis NOS, bipolar disorder with psychosis, or major depressive disorder with psychosis, within the past 5 years - taking stable psychiatric medications with no major medication changes within the past month - see link to clinicaltrials.gov for complete inclusion criteria

Exclusion Criteria:

- have a serious medical, neurological, heart, kidney, or liver condition that could make participation unsafe - are pregnant, planning to become pregnant, or breastfeeding - take certain medications or supplements that may not be safe with the study medication, or have had a serious reaction to modafinil or another medication - have a recent serious alcohol or substance use problem, a history of stimulant use disorder, or current concerns about suicide risk - see link to clinicaltrials.gov for complete exclusion criteria
