Eligibility Criteria

Sex: Male

This study is NOT accepting healthy volunteers

Inclusion Criteria:

- male ages 2 or older - confirmed cerebral adrenoleukodystrophy (cALD) - have had at least two brain MRI scans

Exclusion Criteria:

- had a brain lesion that showed enhancement with gadolinium contrast on their first MRI
